After arriving at the site and upon initial walkthrough and equipment check, we noticed that this area has been frequented by local teenagers and vandalized very heavily. Initial thoughts from the team present were that due to the fact that the location was secluded and heavily traveled is that this site could be nothing more than urban legend.

High tensile power lines, as well as dust and insect concentration affected the use of standard equipment, such as EMF and thermal.

The membership was split into two teams and took turns within the location using both mobile and stationary recorders as well as cameras. Several times the cameras had battery malfunctions on the SW side of the cemetery; this was reported by several members and verified during multiple checks.

Investigator Feeling / Experiences:

As with any situation this location prompted several of our team to feel differently at times; no heavy feeling of being watched was noted. Several of the team reported "heaviness" while approaching an area of the location that is its centralized point. Most of the team felt at ease at this location.

Chris F. – Reflections; heavy feeling while doing EVP in pine grove.

Kevin J. – Battery drain near KUKUK grave; this happened twice in the same area. Battery went back to full power after exiting.

Deana M. – During EVP work, black shadow seen. Heavy feeling walking up to pine grove, lasting 5 to 10 seconds.

Alyssa M. – Odd reflection in picture that did not repeat in same area.

Wendy F. – Feelings of being drawn to NE corner of location; flash problems in that area. Foggy spots noted in trees in the middle of the location.

Wayne M. - Battery drains near KUKUK grave.

Jo G. - Battery drain near KUKUK grave, as well as in middle near pine grove.

Kristy J. - Orb photo in SE area of location, as well as Flash problems NE corner.

Evidence Review and Findings

EVPs:

No EVPs reported by any of the team. Jo, however, has a portion of tape that will be reviewed once transferred to digital media. All of the recorders picked up substantial background noise.

Video:

No evidence to report.

Photographs:

Several interesting anomalies were reviewed by the membership and will be posted in this thread for user review. Dust and condensation as well as reflective surface and background lighting are heavy in most pictures taken at this location.

EMF:

Overhead and in-ground power lines present; these caused the team's EMF meters to be of limited use.

Thermal:

Not used due to temperature change.

Observation:

After talking with all of the team and reviewing all submitted evidence, MPI is stating that this area had no activity at the time of our visit. It may be due to the fact of the local population and its usage of the site that could have caused this rumor of the site to have activity. Also noted could be the effect of the power lines on those that might be sensitive to high EMF. The team is in agreement of this, upon examination and investigation of the site.
