Evidence Review and Findings

EVP:

As is standard protocol several different devices were used while in this location. The recording devices were both stationary and mobile and were placed in areas noted by the homeowner. Both digital and analog (cassette) devices were used and the contents were submitted for review and analysis. Upon review the digital recorders did not contain anything paranormal in nature; however the micro cassette device that was carried by the team sensitives did have several interesting captures that were noted. Several unexplainable voices did appear; in addition, a full vocal response to a question was recorded. (See client copy disc for these audio segments)

Video:

Two units were used at this location, the Hi-8 as well as the mini DV camcorders. Both units were placed as stationary in "active" areas as indicated by the homeowner. Upon submission and review there was no anomalous activity captured on either device.

Photographs:

After a review of all submitted photographs only several photos were brought for review. Several “orb” photographs stand out due to their size and color; however, these were all taken in the basement of the home and could be explained by dust particles or other elements. EMF:

No readings taken due to exposed cable and fixtures within close proximity to the upstairs area and coaxial as well as dated BX armor cable present in the basement. False reading probabilities are high in this location.

Thermal:

Ambient temperature gauge used. No substantial changes were noted by the investigative team.

Final:

The review of the all of the evidence vollected was important in this case. As this report states, several interesting audio responses were captured by MPI during the investigation of this location. The sensitives present picked up on several impressions that did support not only the evidence captured but did help to verify the homeowners claims of some of the activity that has been happening. One item in particular was removed from the residence as it is believed to be the catalyst of most of the activity. MPI at this time can report that with the unexplainable audio that was captured at this location it does support the presence of paranormal activity in the home.

Upon the request of the homeowner we will be returning on 3/31/07 with our team to document the “cleansing” of this affected object. We hope that this will clear the home of this activity and place the homeowners at ease. A supplemental report will be issued upon review of this new data gathered and will be submitted by the field lead upon review.
