Evidence Review and Findings

EVP:

As is standard protocol several different devices were used while in this location, the recording devices were both stationary and mobile and were placed in areas noted by the homeowner. Both digital and magnetic devices were used and the contents were submitted for review and analysis. Upon review the digital recorders did not contain anything paranormal in nature.

Video:

Two units were used at this location, the digital as well as the mini DV recorder. A stationary device was placed in the master bedroom of the location to try to capture the anomalies as stated by the homeowner. The mini DV was used as a mobile device to document any other area of the home that was said to have activity. Upon review and analysis of all evidence no anomalies were present to substantiate the homeowner's claim of activity. The homeowner had provided the research team with video that she had taken but the quality of the video had severe grain and at this time it is impossible to tell exactly what the video had captured. We at MPI can compare the objects captured on the submitted video to dust in flight or natural flying objects (bugs).

Photographs:

Upon review of all submitted photographs no anomalous activity was noted by the team.

EMF:

Two EMF gauges were used and a baseline was conducted and mapped throughout the entire residence. In more than one location several high spikes were noted, after another sweep of the location we found that the hangers in the drop ceiling may have ruptured the old “bell” wiring causing the frame of the ceiling to hold a light charge. We also found that in the areas that the homeowner had made claims of activity also had extremely high pockets of EMF. (See attached baseline map and final for remarks)

Thermal:

Ambient temperature gauge was used; no substantial changes were noted by the investigative team. The inside of the residence was constant at 68 degrees.

Final:

Upon review of all submitted evidence by the team present at the time of the investigation, we can conclude that the residence in question displayed no sign of paranormal activity at the time of our visit. However, upon analysis the home has a electrical issue emanating from the original “bell” wiring that was used in the home’s early construction. This also would substantiate the pockets of EMF that were found throughout the home. In instances such as this it will cause the home to discharge small electrical currents much like sparks or lights that may account for some of the occurrences noted by the homeowner. Also, extremely high concentrations of EMF are known to cause health problems as well as hallucinations when a person is exposed for long periods of time.

After a consultation with the homeowner we recommended that the homeowner has the old wiring checked for any current value and have it deemed as inactive if that is the case. We believe at this time that this is a majority of the problem at this location. We also asked the homeowner to make note if she felt any different away from the residence - if she feels better while away this would only substantiate that EMF is causing the problems. We will remain in contact with the homeowner to inquire if this activity is continuing after the appropriate wiring checks are made. Attached to this report is a brief outline of what can happen in the case of high EMF so the homeowner can make reference to it.
