**Location Condition:**

Historic building with basement and upper level; formerly the site of a hotel and several other businesses prior to the area being destroyed by a fire. (See historical documentation)

**Location Weather:**

The weather at the location was overcast and cold at our arrival; during the duration of the investigation, a breeze was blowing to the south east.

**Note:**

All recording equipment was loaded with both fresh batteries and recording media as is MPI investigation protocol, and voice checks were performed for recognition and recording quality. All media was transferred to digital file for review upon completion of the investigation.

## Evidence Review and Findings

### Photographs:

As is standard protocol for MPI, several hundred photographs were taken at various areas throughout this location. Upon review, no photographs contained anything considered paranormal in nature. However, several interesting “orb” photographs were captured at this location.

### EVP:

**Digital #1** (stationary device in upstairs) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

**Digital #2** (All mobile devices) - No physical evidence captured on these devices at the time of the investigation.

**Micro Cassette** (Mobile device) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

**Standard Cassette** (Stationary in office area in the basement) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

### Video:

**Digital** (Stationary in main room of basement) - Upon review of the footage from this device several anomalous instances did appear in the basement area that could not be explained. (See attached video for review)

**Mini DV** (Stationary in office area of basement) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

**Hi-8** (Stationary in storage room of basement) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

### EMF:

Both EMF devices were used during the investigation in several areas, but due to the wiring of this location the meters would spike at random and an accurate reading could not be obtained.

### **Thermal:**

Both the Laser Contact Gauge (LCG) as well as the Ambient Temperature Gauge (ATG) were used at this location. The baseline reading of the location varied between 68 and 71 degrees; colder temperatures were noted in the basement area but could be accounted for by the dated foundation. No other notations of “cold spots” were captured on either device by the investigative team.

### **Investigator Feeling / Experiences:**

**(Note: Personal experiences cannot in itself determine paranormal activity in a location, unless documented by video or audio equipment)**

**Deana M.** – Uneasy feelings in the basement area; witnessed furniture in basement move slightly; shadows seen in kitchen area; cold spots felt on main floor.

**Wayne M.** – No personal experiences to report.

**Chris F.** – Heard furniture moving upstairs (main floor) while posted in the basement. Upon checking with the investigators posted there, it was determined that they were not in the location of the noise at the time it was made.

**Wendy F.** - Noises in office area (basement); noises in kitchen area; uneasy feelings in the storage room (basement).

**Amy M.** - Uneasy feelings in several areas of this location; possible shadow sighting in kitchen as well as heard noises in that area.

**Tim F.** - Uneasy feeling in upstairs area; shadow sighting in kitchen area; possible apparition of face in basement area.

### **Conclusion:**

After a careful analysis of all data and evidence collected, the team has determined that we must return to this location for a follow up investigation to try and document further the activity that is taking place there. Several of the investigative team’s experiences substantiate the location’s activity that was outlined to us during the initial consultation interviews and coincide with the staff experiences that were documented. We also will be returning with our staff sensitive to do a walkthrough of this location on another scheduled date to get a better view of the activity. During the time of the investigation we were able to capture some interesting video footage and will present it to the client on 5/23/07 for review.
