**Evidence Review and Findings**

**EVP:**

Digital – Both mobile and stationary recorders were used, upon review of all submitted files no audio evidence was captured on the devices present.

Micro Cassette – Two mobile units were used, no audio evidence captured on either device.

**Video:**

Digital – (Mobile unit) No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of our visit.

**Photographs:**

Several hundred photographs were taken at this location, many were filled with typical “orbs” that could be explained away by the insects and humidity in the air. However there were several photographs that had dark anomalies that could not be explained. (See attached photographs)
