**Location Condition:**

Historic building with basement and upper level; formerly the site of a hotel and several other businesses prior to the area being destroyed by a fire. (See historical documentation)

**Note:**

All recording equipment was loaded with both fresh batteries and recording media as is MPI investigation protocol, and voice checks were performed for recognition and recording quality. All media was transferred to digital file for review upon completion of the investigation.

## Evidence Review and Findings

### Photographs:

As is standard protocol for MPI, several hundred photographs were taken at various areas throughout this location. Upon review, no photographs contained anything considered paranormal in nature.

### EVP:

Per MPI procedure, both mobile and stationary audio recorders were used during the investigation. Upon thorough analysis of all of the submitted audio we were able to capture on several of the mobile units “whispers” at different areas of the location. We could not clearly understand what was said, nor could we substantiate that they were paranormal in nature. Several interesting audio clips did however yield what sounds like vocal response that could be made out upon review. (See attached audio files)

### Video:

**Digital** (Stationary in office area) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

**Mini DV** (Stationary in upstairs main room) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

**Hi-8** (Stationary in upstairs hallway) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

**DVR** (stationary in basement main room in two locations) – On camera #2 a transparent light anomaly was captured with an unusual flight pattern not consistent with natural phenomena. However we cannot be certain of its origin. No physical evidence captured on camera #1 at the time of the investigation. (See attached video file)

### EMF:

Both EMF devices were used during the investigation in several areas but due to the wiring of this location the meters would spike at random and an accurate reading could not be obtained.

### Thermal:

No distinct temperature changes were noted with this device at the time of the investigation.

### **Investigator Feeling / Experiences:**

**(Note: Personal experiences cannot in itself determine paranormal activity in a location, unless documented by video or audio equipment)**

**Chris F.** – Witnessed computer come on in office, heard possible footsteps upstairs; felt cold spots in basement.

**Wayne M.** - No experiences to report.

**Wendy F.** – Witnessed computer in office come on; feelings of heat and dizziness in basement storage area; heard noises on stairs while in main room of the basement; heard the sound of bottles moving while in the main room of basement.

**Deana M.** – Felt hot spots almost like fire heat in basement storage room; heard noises on the stairs; felt uneasy in the basement storage room.

**Will** – Was in back the section of the main basement room when all of a sudden I felt very uncomfortable and felt like I was being watched and left that area immediately.

**Dave** – Heard a noise from the storage room while in the main room in the basement; had the feeling of being watched while in the same area; heard what sounded like a footstep on the main level while in the basement; smelled a cologne type scent while in the upstairs main room and then it was gone.

**Opie** – Witnessed the computer come on in the office area and a few seconds after that felt something cold “brush” past his leg and the room was notably cooler afterwards.

### **Sensitive Report:**

On this investigation we had our sensitive staff return with the team to the location for another “reading” of the building and its surroundings. We utilized a different tactic with the four that were present, keeping them separate and making sure they did not exchange information until they were completed with their respective walkthroughs. We placed one on each floor and had them carry recording devices with them to try not only to document their findings for this report but to also collect evidence. After their vigil was complete they were able to pick up on several new things, as well as confirm some instances that the historical data can verify. There were also several instances that one of the sensitives was able to pick up that were of a personal nature pertaining to the client, and of which only the client would know. The sensitive informed the client of these “persons” surrounding him and he was able to verify with detail that they were indeed persons whom the client had known.

At our next investigation we will again be changing our tactics with regards to our sensitive staff. They have been to this location several times and we feel that they have been “saturated.” Therefore we will have them sit stationary and only do standard EVP questioning and not perform a read of the location. We believe that they have been able

to pick up on numerous things throughout this ongoing investigation but do not want to compromise the investigation or its findings due to the information that has already been reviewed up to this point.

**Conclusion:**

As this and previous reports indicate, we continue to have many personal experiences at each visit. We also continue to track and document the activity that occurs at this location. At each investigation we continually expand on our arsenal of equipment as well as try new techniques to draw the activity out into the open. We cannot at this time indicate exactly what the activity is, nor its exact origin, but we can say that activity of an anomalous nature is present at this location in several areas. We have in the past caught several interesting video clips, as well as audio clips on this last investigation that cannot be explained by natural occurrence. We hope to continue our research and working with the client to try to capture more evidence and gather more data in future investigations of this location. We will be meeting with the client to go over this report as well as present our findings on 7/25/07.
