All recording equipment was loaded with both fresh batteries and recording media as is MPI investigation protocol, and voice checks were performed for recognition and recording quality. All media was transferred to digital file for review upon completion of the investigation.

Evidence Review and Findings

Photographs:

As is standard protocol for MPI, several hundred photographs were taken at various areas throughout this location. Upon review, no photographs contained anything unusual in nature.

EVP:

During the investigation both mobile and stationary audio recorders were used per MPI procedure. Upon thorough analysis of all of the submitted audio data, no anomalous activity was detected.

Video:

Digital (Stationary in main bar area facing south) - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation. One audio anomaly was captured on this device.

DVR (Stationary in basement main room) – On camera #1 a light anomaly was captured not consistent with natural phenomena. However we cannot be certain of its origin.

EMF:

Both EMF devices were used during the investigation in but, as in past investigations, due to the wiring of this location the meters would spike at random and an accurate reading could not be obtained.

Thermal:

No distinct temperature changes were noted with this device at the time of the investigation.
