Location Condition:

Ten room home, relatively new construction (seven years) sitting on large parcel of land with an outlying barn. No further notes taken at the time of consultation interview and baseline session.

Location Weather:

Team members arrived at the investigation site after nightfall. The temperature continued to drop all evening along with a light breeze and clear skies. This was an indoor investigation and temperatures inside the residence were at nominal all evening long with no anomalous readings.

Equipment Placement - Video:

DVR Camera #1 – Located in bedroom #1

DVR Camera #2 – Located in bedroom #2

Mini DVD W/Nightshot– Located in bedroom #3

Equipment Placement - Audio:

Mobile Units – Each investigative team had at least one mobile recording unit on hand during each investigation rotation and area.

Stationary – Located in bedroom #1 on dresser.

Note:

All mobile units were outfitted with external microphones to limit possible contamination of audio evidence.

Case History – Consultation Notes

Consultation Date: February 20th 2008

MPI Representative: Kyle B.

Reported Activity:

Physical movement, apparitions, voices, cold spots, toys going off by themselves, physical ailments.

Age / Length of activity – The activity was noted as starting in the residence in early 2005 and is currently ongoing, according to the homeowner.

Hot Spots – Two bedrooms used by the occupants of the home: one a child’s bedroom and the other belonging to the homeowner.

Notes: The youngest child has seen and heard several apparitions in his bedroom and refuses to sleep in that area, and will not sleep through the night without a person present with him. The child has, on several occasions (and witnessed by several persons), told the presence to “get away.” In addition, toys within the room have both moved and gone off without being moved or touched by anyone present.

A former occupant of the home has also had trouble sleeping in the same bedroom and would often wake up screaming. The homeowner would wake up to someone calling their name when they were the only person in the home as well as feel “cold spots”.

Numerous apparitions were reported in the home by its occupants in the child’s bedroom, such as a young boy that would play with the toys in the toy box; an older man; a “black man,” as well as a woman in a pink shirt. Furthermore, the homeowner’s pet dog will not enter either of the rooms.

Evidence Review & Findings

Photographs:

As is MPI protocol, numerous photographs were taken at this location and upon review no anomalous photographs were entered at the time of this report close.

EVP:

Mobile Units – No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

Stationary Units - No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

Video:

DVR Camera #1 – No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

DVR Camera #2 – No physical evidence captured on this device at the time of the investigation.

Note: No Thermal or EMF gauges were used during the duration of the investigation.

Investigator Feeling / Experiences:

(Note: Personal experiences cannot in itself determine paranormal activity in a location, unless documented by video or audio equipment)

Wayne M. – No personal experiences to report.

Deana M. – No personal experiences to report.

Kevin J. – While in bedroom # 1 I kept seeing a black shadow in the mirror that was hanging on the wall, also had several malfunctions with my digital recorder during the session.

Investigator Feelings / Experiences (Cont.)

Kristie J. – Felt cold spots in bedroom # 1. I thought I saw shadows while in the same area.

Conclusion:

Per MPI protocol, all photos, audio, and video taken during the investigation was carefully reviewed by multiple team members. Audio was downloaded and examined using audio analysis software. Each video piece was reviewed separately, and photos were carefully examined. MPI was not able to capture any anomalous events on any of the recording devices. This in no way disproves the claims of paranormal activity of the homeowners; it just shows that no anomalous activity occurred during MPI's investigation. If the homeowners are still experiencing activity they may contact MPI for further investigation.
